

### **School Uniform Policy**

Governors believe that uniform contributes to a positive school ethos and encourages a sense of belonging and equality within the school family.

Over 75% of parents agree that a school uniform is important to create a sense of belonging.

In agreeing this policy, Governors have taken into account the views of parents, the cost of items of uniform and the year round availability of uniform for parents.

#### Aims:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Establishes a sense of community and belonging towards the school
- Is practical and smart
- Promotes equality and should not be gender specific
- Is regarded as suitable wear for school and good value for money by most parents
- Is designed with health and safety in mind
- Uniform should be easily obtainable for parents

#### Hair

Hair must be appropriate for school and not cause a distraction from learning Long hair should be tied back

Head coverings may be worn but must be black/grey/Green/ White in colour

Hair accessories must be small and black/grey/white/green in colour and not cause a distraction to learning

#### General appearance:

Jewellery is not to be worn at school with the exception of small stud earrings. This is entirely based on health and safety requirements.

Jewellery and articles of faith worn for religious reasons is permitted.

A watch, including a fitness tracker, can be worn but must not distract the child from learning.

## **Dynamos and Nursery**

Children should all wear black bottoms and a white t-shirt like the rest of the school. If parents wish to purchase a logoed jumper/cardigan they may.

# **Purchasing Uniform:**

The only items that have the school logo on are the jumper and the cardigan. These can be purchased from Brigade online. From January 2022 logoed uniform will also be available to buy from a shop local to school.

The bookbag has the school logo on and can be purchased from Brigade.

Every other item of uniform is available at all supermarkets and clothing shops. These are not school specific to make it easier for parents to buy.

## Non-compliance:

The Department for Education are clear that teachers can discipline children for breaching the school's rules on uniform and appearance. This would be carried out in accordance with the school's behaviour policy.

To avoid this happening, Governors would like to ensure that all parents support their children in dressing appropriately for school.
