This project supports children with settling into the new rules and routines of school and encourages them to make new friends and feel confident in their class. It teaches children about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and at school. This project also teaches children how they are unique and special, the importance of friendship and how people in their family, school and local community are important and can help them.

We are hoping the children are going to enjoy this topic. This project supports children to develop a love of stories and reading. It encourages children to learn, retell and act out familiar and traditional tales including Cinderella, Goldilocks, Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs and The Three Billy Goats Gruff.

Celebrations

In Nursery we teach children about different celebrations from around the world.

Library Books:

Once the children have settled in, we will introduce library books to the children, they will choose a story from nursery and take it home in their book bag, you will need to provide a book bag. We will change it every Wednesday.

Eating with a knife and fork
Drinking from an open cup
Zipping up their own coat

Help your child be more independent.

Other info:

All items that the children bring in need to be labelled, coats, bottles, lunch bags, jumpers etc. It is really tricky to identify the children's belongings when they are not labelled.
