## This term we are learning...

In Maths, we will have a real focus on numbers to 10. We will learn about counting forwards and backwards and how to find 1 more and 1 less. We will learn how to do simple addition and subtraction and how to partition numbers up to 10. We will then move on to numbers to 20 and we will learn all about 2D and 3D shapes.

As **Geographers**, we will be looking at human and physical features of our school and surrounding areas by carrying out fieldwork. We will use maps and globes to learn about the equator, hemispheres, continents and oceans. We will study maps to learn about the four countries of the United Kingdom and their capital cities. We will also learn to use positional language and become familiar with compass points.



In **Art** we will explore primary and secondary colours and look at how artists use colour in their artwork. We will also explore the concept of portraits and how collage techniques can be used to make portraits.

In **Science**, we will learn about materials and conduct experiments to learn about their properties. We will also learn about human senses and investigate how our senses help us understand our surroundings.

As **Historians**, we will use artefacts to help us understand childhood in the past and how childhood has changed over time. We will explore life in the 1950's, including shopping, transport, family life and childhood using a range of historical sources.

To support our learning in History, we have organised a trip to The Children's Country House at Sudbury on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December.
