This term we are learning about...

In Maths we will be learning about fractions including halves and quarters, position and direction, numbers to 100, money and time.

In Science we will be learning about wild and garden plants in our local environment. We will identify and describe basic parts of plants and observe how they change over time.





We will also be learning about animals, including animal parts, their diets and which animal groups they belong to.

In Art we will be learning about the American pop artist James Rizzi. We will be creating a 3D mural based on Rizzi's work depicting streets and buildings.





In Design Technology we will be learning about sources of food and skills including peeling, tearing, slicing, chopping, mashing and grating.

In History we will be learning about our school and its locality, both today and in the past. We will compare schooling in the Victorian era to our experience today.



To support our learning in History, we have organised a visit to the Black Country Living Museum on Friday 9th May.
