This term we are learning...

History: As historians, we will learn about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the coastal town of Whitby, in Yorkshire.



Art: As artists, we will learn about the visual elements of flowers, including shape, texture, colour, pattern and form. We will also explore various artistic methods, including drawing, printmaking and 3-D forms, using paper and clay.



Science: As

scientists, we will learn about the uses of everyday materials and how materials' properties make them suitable or unsuitable for specific purposes. We will also begin to explore how materials can be changed.

Design Technology: As learners, we will learn about making and strengthening structures, including different ways of joining materials. We will be creating our own beach huts.
