As Geographers, children will study how to locate countries and cities, and use grid references, compass points and latitude and longitude. They learn about the layers of the Earth and plate tectonics and discover the five major climate zones. They learn about

significant places in the United Kingdom and carry out fieldwork to discover how land is used in the locality.

STONE AGE

As historians, children will be learning about the Stone Age, through the Bronze Age and into the Iron Age.

Children will explore changes to people, homes and lifestyle throughout the different periods of time.

As artists, children will study colour theory by

focusing on the colour wheel and colour mixing. It includes an exploration of tertiary colours, warm and cool colours, complementary colours, analogous colours and how artists use colour in their artwork.

As scientists, children will learn about the importance of nutrition for humans and other animals. They learn about the role of a skeleton and muscles and identify animals with different types of skeleton

In computing, children will be learning the process of coding and the terminology surrounding this. They will also be learning how to keep themselves safe following esafety guidance.
