This term we are learning about:

GROUNDBREAKING GREEKS

As <u>Historians</u>, we will learn about different periods of Greek history, exploring the earliest civilisations, the devastation of the Dark Age and the breakthroughs of the Archaic and Classical periods. They will get to know some of the most significant Athenians and understand why Greek art, culture, architecture, philosophy, medicine and mathematics were so significant. We will learn about the leadership of Alexander the Great and discover how ancient Greece became part of the Roman Empire after the Hellenistic period. To complete our learning, we will decide which was the ancient Greeks' greatest idea and explore how the legacy of ancient Greece affects our lives today.



As <u>Artists</u>, we will learn about paper crafts, papermaking and collage techniques, including paper, fabric, mixed media and photo collage.

As <u>Scientists</u>, we will plan and carry out tests to determine the properties of a range of materials. We will identify materials that are thermal conductors and insulators. We will also learn about the property of solubility and test various materials to discover which are soluble and insoluble. We will ask scientific questions about separating unusual mixtures and learn the difference between reversible and irreversible changes, observing the signs of an irreversible change firsthand.

In <u>Design Technology</u>, we will be looking at how architectural style and technology has developed over time to design a building with specific features.

In <u>Computing</u>, learners will explore what can be shared on the World Wide Web, where websites are stored and continue to learn about how to be safe online.
