This term we are learning about:

Maafa

As <u>Historians</u>, children will learn about Africa past and present, with a particular focus on Benin. They will study the development of the slave trade and explores Britain's role in the transatlantic slave trade, the causes and consequences of the European colonisation of Africa and the worldwide communities that make up the African diaspora.

As <u>Scientists</u>, children will learn about the transport role of the human circulatory system, its main parts and primary functions. They will also learn about healthy lifestyle choices and the effects of harmful substances on the body.

As <u>Designers</u>, children will learn about processed food and healthy food choices. They will make bread and pasta sauces and learn about the benefits of whole foods. Children will then plan and make meals as part of a healthy daily menu and evaluate their completed products.

As <u>Artists</u>, children will revisit their learning about colour theory, learn about the use of colour in four art movements and use this knowledge to create a painting with personal meaning. These will be on display at our Leavers' Assembly!
