This term we are learning about:

Frozen Kingdoms

As <u>Geographers</u>, children will learn about the characteristics and features of polar regions. They will also explore the environmental factors that shape and influence them, comparing these to their prior knowledge of other parts of the world.

As <u>Scientists</u>, children will learn about electrical circuits, their components and how they function. They will recognise how the voltage of cells affects the output of a circuit and record circuits using standard symbols. Children will also explore programmable devices, sensors and monitoring. They will then combine this learning to design and make programmable home devices.

As <u>Designers</u>, children will learn about remarkable engineers and significant bridges. They will identify features, such as beams, arches and trusses, and complete a bridge-building engineering challenge.

As <u>Artists</u>, children will study the Inuit way of life, including some of their cultural and artistic traditions. They will learn to create stencils and develop their printing skills. Taking inspiration from Canadian artists, children will also create their own carvings out of soap!
